This is a full-time, salaried non-exempt position with benefits.

Position Summary:

The purpose of this position is to manage and direct the Engineering functions and to meet the goals of the Operating Budget for the facility. This position is responsible for managing and directing the engineering, maintenance, and utility functions at Morgan Hill. This position will provide the technical and engineering expertise to diagnose and solve problems relating to the operation; develop project plans, cost estimates and justification; and, manage the project to completion. This position would also be able to plan, organize and direct the maintenance function to assure that the facility and its equipment is in proper working order to achieve the goals of the operating budget. This position will also interface with the same position at other facilities and with the Corporate Engineering function.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- P & L responsibility of the Engineering & Maintenance Departments.
- Plan, organize and direct the engineering and maintenance programs for the facility. This would include but not be limited to the Preventive Maintenance Program, CMMS, developing and controlling the annual budget.
- Manage the utility usage at the facility.
- Develop the Annual Three Year Facility Capital Plan and other long range planning.
- Work to improve the productivity of the facility.
- Ensure that all safety and governmental regulations and reports are followed. Ensure monthly safety training is completed.
- Manage the waste water system for the facility.
- Perform administrative functions such as reviewing and writing reports, conducting performance reviews, approving expenditures, enforcing rules and making decisions about the purchase of materials or services.
- Provide leadership and guidance to facility maintenance and GMP programs.
- Must be able to work weekends and varies shifts as needed.

Requirements:

- B.S. Mechanical, Electrical or Chemical Engineering with equivalent experience in Industrial Engineering Methods.
- Six to ten years experience in engineering in plant operations including methods analysis and project engineering. Skills to include problem solving, project justification, construction management, purchasing, expediting, cost control and scheduling in a multi-disciplinary environment at a remote location.
- Experience and knowledge in material handling, work performance, labor standards, warehousing, and distribution.
